Hotel Accommodations

Host Hotel: Embassy Suites Riverfront Promenade

The Embassy Suits Riverfront Promenade is located on the Sacramento River adjacent to Historic Old Town Sacramento. The location provides guests with easy access to the Riverside Promenade walking/jogging path, and is close to many other local attractions such as Raley Field, the Crocker Art Museum, Sutter's Fort, Towe Auto Museum, California State Rail Road Museum and the State Capitol. The Embassy Suits amenities include complimentary full cooked-to-order breakfast, and a hosted Manager's Reception every evening. The IOANC has placed a hold on rooms with a choice of two double or one king size bed. (Limited number of king bed rooms available) All guest rooms are two room suites with two flat panel televisions, and a galley kitchen featuring a wet bar, refrigerator, microwave and coffeemaker. The IOANC special room rates are \$89.00 per night plus tax. You may upgrade your room to a "river view" room for an additional \$20.00 per night... Parking has been provided in the hotel parking garage for either self parking, or Valet will park and retrieve your car for you. The parking garage fee has been waved. While this is not as convenient as parking outside your rooms, the other facility amenities will outweigh any inconvenience.

Directions

From the North

Take I-5 going south; exit J Street heading east. Turn right on 3rd Street and turn right on Capitol Mall. Hotel is on the left.

From the South

Take I-5 going north; exit J Street heading east. Make a sharp right onto 3rd Street and turn right on Capitol Mall. Hotel is on the left.

From the East

Take I-80 heading west. Take I-5 south; exit J Street heading east. Turn right on 3rd Street and turn right on Capitol Mall. Hotel is on the left.

From the West

Take I-80 heading east. Take Capitol City Freeway. Take Downtown/ Jefferson Blvd. exit. Take Downtown Sacramento to the Tower Bridge. Cross the bridge. First right is hotel entrance.

Tour Information

Thursday, April 30th Morning Tour

Our tour departs Old Town Sacramento across the Tower Bridge into West Sacramento, to South River Road, where we drive up onto the levee of the Sacramento River. We follow the river for about 20 miles taking a leisurely drive through rural farm country to the town of Clarksburg and the Old Sugar Mill. The community is mostly centered on the two churches in town, the Holland Market, and the volunteer fire department. At the mill we will have a private tour of the Sugar Beet (War Beets) processing plant and enjoy a picnic lunch. The 1930's era Old Sugar Mill closed in 1988. Currently a restored portion of the original mill is home to a modern wine tasting and production facility.

Thursday, April 30th Afternoon Tour

Our afternoon tour takes us back to Historic Old Town Sacramento and to the California State Railroad Museum. The museum is regarded as North America's finest railroad museum, featuring lavishly restored 19th century trains, a million-pound steam locomotive, a plush private railroad car, and a dazzling display of toy trains. The locomotive collection of the California State Railroad Museum contains 19 steam locomotives dating from 1862 to 1944. The Museum's locomotives illustrate the development of steam technology from its early years in the mid-nineteenth century to its climax in the 1940's. Fewer than 30 full-size steam locomotives built prior to 1880 exist in the United States. The Museum has five of these, including Central Pacific Railroad locomotive No. 1, "Gov. Stanford."

Tour Information

Friday, May 1st Morning Tour

Our Friday tour takes us on a short drive to West Sacramento to the California Fuel Cell Partnership facility. This unique collaborative of auto manufacturers, energy companies, fuel cell technology companies and government agencies currently consists of 32 members, working together to achieve a common vision: preparing to commercialize hydrogen fuel technology for the 21st century. This is a great opportunity to see the latest technology in hydrogen fuel cell vehicle research, and take a peek into the future of the automobile.

This tour will be limited to 40 people. Registration for the tour will be on a first come first serve basis, as determined by postmark on the returned State Meet registration.

If the Fuel Cell tour fills up we will contact you about a tour to the Towe Auto Museum.

Lunch is planned for 12:30pm at Logan's Road House.

Friday, May 1st Afternoon Tour

After lunch we take a short drive to the Rams Head Auto Collection. John White has assembled one of the finest private collections of rare and unique vehicles on the west coast. The collection features vehicles shown and awarded prizes in many auto shows, including the prestigious Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance. John is happy to share his collection with other classic car folks. This is a must see, and John White is a gracious host.

The Crocker Collection

In 1869, Judge Edwin B. Crocker and his family assembled a collection of more than 700 paintings and around 1,344 master drawings (one of the finest early collections in the United States) during an extended trip to Europe from 1869-71. Before and after their trip, the Crockers acquired numerous paintings by contemporary California artists, forming the core of what is today one of the state's premier collections of California art.

Class groups will be divided into the following categories: Pre-war, post war to '54, '55 & '56, '57- '58 & '59, '60 & '61, '62 & '63, '64-'65 & '66, '67 & '68, '69 to '75, post '75.

Best of Show Award Policy on Ties

In the event of a tie in the balloting for the Best of Show Award, ¼ of a point will be added for each tour completed by each vehicle. The two Thursday tours each earn ¼ point and the two Friday tours earn ¼ point for a total of 1 point. The ballot committee will verify the tour participation, add extra points earned and determine the winner.
